# 2010 Earthquake

- CS About 300,000 Haitian died
- More than half of Port-au-Prince's schools, governments and administrative buildings damaged or destroyed
- Ministry of Health and Population infrastructure damaged
- **G** Response from nations around the globe



# Effect of Earthquake on Dentistry in Haiti

Refore 2010 earthquake: 350 dentists in Haiti

Report Earthquake

- 3 2 dentists died
- **35** dentists lost their practice
- CS Approx. 10 dentists left the country after the earthquake

Today Haiti has about 300 dentists to serve a population of approximately 10 million people!


Real Service-learning trip to Haiti

- CS Establish a training program in oral health prevention for nurses in Haiti




