COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECT



This year ANDA's Community Service project will be to provide a financial contribution to **Covenant House**, **Orlando**, **FL**. Covenant House works with youth in a variety of disadvantaged situations. Common issues/problems among Covenant House Florida kids include: homelessness and runaways. They come from all socio-economic and ethnic-cultural backgrounds. There is a history of abuse: physical; sexual; substance, emotional,

verbal and violence in the home. children come from difficult family situations: physical and mental health conditions, i.e., acute health problems with respiratory conditions, injuries, and skin disorders; depression or suicidal. There is a lack of education, 84% of youths without a high school diploma have dropped out; the average reading level is grade 7.5. 90% are unemployed.

DENTAL SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

ANDA's annual dental scholarship is awarded to students in their $2^{nd} - 4^{th}$ year of dental school to assist financially in their dental school expenses. We have awarded over \$100,000 in dental scholarships, thanks to your support. Our primary focus for raising funds for dental scholarships and community service projects is through direct contributions. Applications for students have been sent to MeHarry and Howard Dental Schools and are attached to this newsletter.
